

Sugar Cookie Holiday Dog Treat

Yield: 12–24 cookies

Serving size: 1 cookie

Prep time: 20 min.

Total time: 25 min.



Ingredients

- 1 cup kibble, finely ground in a food processor
- 2 1/3 cups whole wheat flour
- 1 cup bone broth for dogs
- 1 large egg, lightly beaten
- 2 tablespoons real maple syrup (do not substitute imitation maple syrup)
- 3 tablespoons cornstarch
- 2 tablespoons water
- 1 ounce Neufchâtel cheese, softened
- Drops of natural food coloring (optional)

Directions

1. Preheat the oven to 350 F. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.
2. In a small bowl, dissolve cornstarch in water. Add softened Neufchâtel cheese and stir until smooth. Let icing sit or prep ahead and chill in fridge.
3. In a large bowl, mix ground kibble and flour. In a separate bowl, whisk together the broth, egg, and maple syrup. Pour wet mixture into dry and stir until combined. Knead dough until smooth.
4. On a floured surface, roll dough to 1/4" thick. Use a festive cookie cutter to cut out shapes.
5. Place cookies on the prepared sheet and bake for 20–25 minutes, or until lightly browned and firm. Let cool completely.
6. Decorate with icing then let set for 20 minutes before serving your pup.

Check with your vet before serving your dog new foods.

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
